MLCN Investment Management Corporation Bursary

Three bursaries are available up to \$10,000 per student, per administrative school year. Students will be selected based on the following criteria: i) demonstrated financial need; and ii) other measures of merit including demonstrated volunteer work and involvement in the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation community (or, if living outside the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation community, volunteer work in support of other Indigenous communities will be considered).
